rabbittransit Celebrates Try Transit Month for September

York, PA – rabbittransit celebrates September as Try Transit Month. Delivering more than 1.5 million trips a year in the region, rabbittransit offers public transportation as a resource for the community.

Here are 10 Try Transit highlights that area residents might not be aware of:

- #1: **Calling all Commuters**: rabbittransit offers weekday service, known as rabbit*EXPRESS*, between York and Harrisburg, York and Northern Maryland and between Gettysburg and Harrisburg.
- #2: **Seniors Ride Free**: Thanks to the Pennsylvania Lottery, registered seniors over the age 65 ride fixed route and rabbit *EXPRESS* buses for free.
- #3: **Take a Virtual Tour**: Those interested in rabbit *EXPRESS* can take a 360 degree tour inside the bus at one of the park and ride locations at: http://www.rabbittransit.org/Schedules/rabbitEXPRESS360Tour.aspx.
- #4: **Bikeshare to Bus Stop**: Residents not close to a bus stop can connect with a bicycle or rent a Zagster bike to connect at http://bike.zagster.com/yorkcitypa/.
- #5: **Accessible Transportation**: Loved ones with limited mobility can utilize the Shared Ride Paratransit service, which offers door-to-door service from home. All vehicles are ADA accessible for wheelchairs or other mobility devices.
- #6: Free WiFi: WiFi is available onboard rabbit EXPRESS vehicles to make commute time productive.
- #7: Budget Bargain: Unlimited rides for \$42 for a month. Stretch household dollars farther.
- #8: **Food Friendly**: GIANT Food Stores generously sponsors free transportation through rabbittransit to two of its locations. http://www.rabbittransit.org/Schedules/YorkFixedRoute/GIANTShuttles.aspx.
- #9 **Try Transit Contest**: Those who log transit trips can be entered to win a Kindle Fire or two Amtrak coach class tickets on the Amtrak Keystone Service (valid from Harrisburg to New York City) through Commuter Services of Pennsylvania http://pacommuterservices.org.
