- PA Labor & Industry Office of Vocational Rehabilitation some of this group has heard about OVR scaling back on programs and possibly going to back an order of selection (VR Waiting List) due to limited federal funding for FFY 2025 (starts 10/1/24). Transportation programs which could be impacted in OVR: transit provider contracts for OVR customers, funding for driver simulations, travel training, vehicle modifications / funding and the Financial Needs Test (FNT) for students with disabilities. Discussed at recent OVR and PA Rehabilitation Council. RCPA Urges Senators to Preserve OVR Employment Funding - RCPA (paproviders.org)
- Harrisburg Area Transportation (HATS) -through Tri County Planning Commission-we need more consumers and disability organizations to attend. See here for more details (background, prior meeting minutes and upcoming sessions)

<u>SRTA Business & Transportation Updates – Sherry Welsh</u>

- Reminder of October 1st, 2024, paratransit fare increase.

- The 1W (York area) will be increasing frequency on October 6th, 2024.
- Berwick micro transit service launching October 6th, 2024.

Harrisburg facility reconstruction - AJ Thackra, Stantec Inc. & Rich Farr

Mr. Thackra shared a PowerPoint and blueprints of the reconstruction of the Harrisburg facility. It can take up to approximately 4 years to complete. Keep in mind that it is a transfer center not a transit center and while it will have pedestrian access, it is designed for time point transfers. The idea is to be able to get off 1 bus and onto the next ASAP. The transfer center will have standard signs as well as a PA system for the visually impaired including ADA requirements information board on routes.

Fixed route ridership: 107,225. 1,432 more riders than in 8/2023.

• 50% on time, 26% late, 24% early.

Paratransit ridership: 6,026 total trips booked.

- No shows 703 total = 5,323 trips completed.
- 87% on time,14% late.

Customer service feedback/complaints – 9 MATP.

Performance Metrics

August 2024 York/Adams:

Fixed route ridership: 126,859. 1,516 more riders than in 8/2023.

• 76% on time, 10% late, 14% early.

Paratransit ridership: 50,544 trips booked.

• 3,651 no-shows = 46,893 trips completed. 86% on time, 15% late

<u>Dauphin, York & Adams Call Center</u> – 40,806 total calls. 32,376 answered, 8,430 dropped. 79% answer rate.
